

**BUSINESS CORPORATION ACT (EXCERPT)**  
**Act 284 of 1972**

**450.1913 Destruction or disposition of corporate documents by county clerk.**

Sec. 913. The county clerk may destroy the copies of the corporate documents of a domestic or foreign corporation which were forwarded to his or her office in accordance with Act No. 327 of the Public Acts of 1931, as amended, being sections 450.62 to 450.192 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, and its predecessor act. The clerk may destroy or dispose of these records in accordance with section 5 of Act No. 271 of the Public Acts of 1913, as amended, being section 399.5 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
