

THE MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET ACT (EXCERPT)
Act 431 of 1984

18.1124 Director; powers and duties generally.

Sec. 124. The director may organize the department into organizational entities and may merge or transfer functions between organizational entities to promote efficiency and economy. The director shall exercise direction and supervision over the organization entities in the performance of the respective functions. The director may appoint deputies and other officers and employees as permitted by law to effectively accomplish the duties and responsibilities of the department. The director may designate a deputy or other employee to act on behalf of the director.
