¹The information contained in this table only details the membership of the Michigan house of representatives for the session years 1989-1998. It is not necessarily indicative of the total length of service of any one member in the house.

²The decennial reapportionment of Michigan house of representative districts was approved May 21, 1982. Implementation of the reapportionment plan resulted in a change in the district number of eighteen representatives (Brotherton, Ciaramitaro, DeBeaussaert, Evans, Fitzpatrick, Gilmer, Kilpatrick, Mahalak, McNamee, McNeely, Muxlow, Padden, Scott, S. Stopczynski, Strand, Trim, Van Singel, Watkins) whose service spanned that period. Those changes became effective for the November 1982 general election.

The decennial reapportionment of the Michigan house of representatives was approved on April 1, 1992, and became effective for the November 1992 general election. For each member who served in the 87th Legislature as well as in the 86th Legislature, his or her district number under the 1982 plan is shown first in the District column of the table, followed by his or her district number under the 1992 plan, provided the district number was changed under the 1992 plan.

³Elected to the Michigan senate June 18, 1991; resigned from the house of representatives June 27, 1991; succeeded by John Jamian September 11, 1991.

⁴Elected to the Michigan senate June 4, 1996; resigned from the house of representatives June 7, 1996; succeeded by Nancy Cassis, elected at November 5, 1996 special election (held in conjunction with general election), who took office November 12, 1996.

⁵Died October 21, 1996; succeeded by Gloria Schermesser, elected at November 5, 1996 special election (held in conjunction with general election), who took office November 12, 1996.
