

MICHIGAN ELECTION LAW (EXCERPT)
Act 116 of 1954

168.24e Board of county canvassers; meetings; election of officers; quorum, action; clerk; assistants, compensation.

Sec. 24e. The board shall meet as necessary to transact their business, and during the month of January in each even numbered year elect one of their members chairman and one as vice-chairman. Any 3 members shall constitute a quorum but no action shall become effective unless 1 member from each political party represented concurs therein.

The county clerk shall be the clerk of the board of county canvassers. The board of county canvassers may employ such assistants as are necessary adequately to perform the duties of the board, and the payment for the assistants shall be in amounts authorized by the board of county canvassers and shall be paid from an appropriation made for that purpose by the board of supervisors prior to the canvass.
