SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5976

A bill to amend 1973 PA 116, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to prescribe powers and duties of certain departments of this state and adoption facilitators; to provide penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

(MCL 722.111 to 722.128) by adding section 4c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4c. (1) With the written approval from the department, an
- 2 operator of a family child care home or group child care home who
- 3 has a regular license with no pending disciplinary action,
- 4 including, but not limited to, a provisional license, refusal to
- 5 renew, or revocation or increased monitoring due to violation of a





- 1 rule or law, may submit a written request to the department to care
- 2 for additional unrelated school-age children during before- or
- 3 after-school hours.
- 4 (2) Upon approval from the department, a family child care
- 5 home may care for 2 additional unrelated school-age children during
- 6 before- or after-school care hours. The existing square footage
- 7 requirement must be met to obtain departmental approval.
- 8 (3) Upon approval from the department, a group child care home
- 9 may care for 4 additional unrelated school-age children during
- 10 before- or after-school care hours. The existing square footage
- 11 requirement must be met to obtain departmental approval.
- 12 (4) The department shall rescind the written approval of 2
- 13 additional school-age children for an operator of a family child
- 14 care home if a recommendation is made for disciplinary action, as
- 15 described in subsection (2), including, but not limited to,
- 16 increased monitoring of that license due to substantial or willful
- 17 violation of a rule or law.
- 18 (5) The department shall rescind the written approval of 4
- 19 additional school-age children for an operator of a group child
- 20 care home if a recommendation is made for disciplinary action, as
- 21 described in subsection (3), including, but not limited to,
- 22 increased monitoring of that license due to a substantial or
- 23 willful violation of a rule or law.
- 24 (6) While providing before- or after-school care, an operator
- 25 of a family child care home approved under this section is exempt
- 26 from counting up to 2 additional unrelated school-age children in
- 27 the ratio of child care personnel to children as allowed in the

 - (7) While providing before- or after-school care, an operator

- 2 from counting up to 4 additional unrelated school-age children in
- 3 the ratio of child care personnel to children as allowed in the
- 4 administrative rules.

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- (8) As used in this section:
- 6 (a) "Before- or after-school care" means child care during the
- 7 hours of 5 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 6 p.m. on school days.
- 8 Before- or after-school care does not apply to a school break from
- 9 regularly scheduled classes, including spring, summer, and winter
- 10 break, or when school is closed for observing a state or federal
- 11 holiday or a snow day.
- 12 (b) "Child care personnel" means an individual who is 14 years
- 13 of age or older to whom 1 or more of the following apply:
- (i) The individual is employed by a group child care home or
- 15 family child care home for compensation, including a contract
- 16 employee or a self-employed individual.
- 17 (ii) An individual whose activities involve the unsupervised
- 18 care or supervision of children for a group child care home or
- 19 family child care home.
- 20 (iii) An individual who has unsupervised access to children who
- 21 are cared for or supervised by a group child care home or family
- 22 child care home.
- 23 (iv) An individual who acts in the role of a licensee designee.
