SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6031

A bill to amend 1974 PA 154, entitled "Michigan occupational safety and health act,"

(MCL 408.1001 to 408.1094) by adding section 85.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 85. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act,
- 2 an employer is not liable under this act for an employee's exposure
- 3 to COVID-19 if the employer was operating in compliance with all
- 4 federal, state, and local statutes, rules, and regulations,
- 5 executive orders, and agency orders related to COVID-19 that had
- 6 not been denied legal effect at the time of the exposure. An
- 7 isolated, de minimis deviation from strict compliance with such
- 8 statutes, rules, regulations, executive orders, and agency orders
- 9 unrelated to the employee's exposure to COVID-19 does not deny an

- 1 employer the immunity provided in this section.
- 2 (2) This section does not do any of the following:
- 3 (a) Create, recognize, or ratify a claim or cause of action of
- 4 any kind.
- 5 (b) Eliminate a required element of a claim of any kind
- 6 including, but not limited to, a causation or proximate cause
- 7 element.
- 8 (c) Amend, repeal, alter, or affect any other immunity or
- 9 limitation of liability.
- 10 (d) Affect a right, remedy, or protection under the worker's
- 11 disability compensation act of 1969, 1969 PA 317, MCL 418.101 to
- 12 418.941, including the exclusive application of this act.
- 13 (3) This section applies retroactively to an exposure to
- 14 COVID-19 that occurs after March 1, 2020.
