

HOUSE BILL No. 4854

May 22, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Bennane and DeMars and referred to the Committee on Social Services and Youth.

A bill to amend Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1973, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to provide penalties; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

as amended, being sections 722.111 to 722.128 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 2a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1973, as
2 amended, being sections 722.111 to 722.128 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 2a to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 2A. A CHILD CARE CENTER OR DAY CARE CENTER, A FAMILY
6 DAY CARE HOME, AND A GROUP CARE HOME SHALL HAVE AT LEAST 1 PERSON
7 WHO HAS SATISFACTORILY COMPLETED TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION IN

1 BASIC FIRST AID AND INFANT AND CHILD CARDIOPULMONARY
2 RESUSCITATION OFFERED BY THE AMERICAN RED CROSS OR A COMPARABLE
3 ORGANIZATION OR INSTITUTION ON DUTY AT ALL TIMES WHILE THE CENTER
4 OR HOME IS PROVIDING CARE TO CHILDREN.
