## **HOUSE BILL No. 4979**

June 19, 1991, Introduced by Rep. Trim and referred to the Committee on House Oversight.

A bill to amend section 26 of Act No. 388 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled

"Michigan campaign finance act,"

as amended by Act No. 95 of the Public Acts of 1989, being section 169.226 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 21a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 26 of Act No. 388 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1976, as amended by Act No. 95 of the Public Acts of 1989, being
- 3 section 169.226 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended and
- 4 section 21a is added to read as follows:
- 5 SEC. 21A. (1) A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE FOR A CANDIDATE FOR
- 6 ELECTIVE OFFICE SHALL ACCEPT CONTRIBUTIONS ONLY AS PROVIDED IN
- 7 THIS SECTION.

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- 1 (2) A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE FOR A CANDIDATE FOR ELECTIVE
- 2 OFFICE SHALL ONLY ACCEPT CONTRIBUTIONS DURING EACH ELECTION CYCLE
- 3 SO THAT THE CUMULATIVE TOTAL OF THE CANDIDATE'S FUNDS IS EQUAL TO
- 4 OR LESS THAN THE PRODUCT OF 50 CENTS AND THE NUMBER OF REGISTERED
- 5 VOTERS IN THE DISTRICT OR MUNICIPALITY IN WHICH HE OR SHE IS
- 6 SEEKING ELECTION.
- 7 (3) A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE FOR A CANDIDATE FOR ELECTIVE
- 8 OFFICE SHALL ONLY ACCEPT CONTRIBUTIONS DURING EACH ELECTION CYCLE
- 9 SO THAT NOT MORE THAN 50% OF THE CUMULATIVE TOTAL OF THE
- 10 CANDIDATE'S FUNDS CONSIST OF CONTRIBUTIONS FROM INDEPENDENT COM-
- 11 MITTEES AND POLITICAL COMMITTEES.
- 12 Sec. 26. (1) A campaign statement of a committee, other
- 13 than a political party committee, required by this act shall con-
- 14 tain all of the following information:
- 15 (a) The filing committee's name, address, and telephone
- 16 number, and the full name, residential and business addresses,
- 17 and telephone numbers of its THE committee treasurer.
- (b) Under the heading "receipts", the total amount of con-
- 19 tributions received during the period covered by the campaign
- 20 statement; under the heading "expenditures", the total amount of
- 21 expenditures made during the period covered by the campaign
- 22 statement; and the cumulative amount of those totals.
- 23 Forgiveness of a loan shall not be included in the totals.
- 24 Payment of a loan by a third party shall be recorded and reported
- 25 as an in-kind contribution by the third party. In-kind contribu-
- 26 tions or expenditures shall be listed at fair market value and
- 27 shall be reported as both contributions and expenditures. A

- 1 contribution or expenditure which THAT is by other than
- 2 completed and accepted payment, gift, or other transfer, which
- 3 is clearly not legally enforceable, and which is expressly
- 4 withdrawn or rejected and returned before a campaign statement
- 5 closing date need not be included in the campaign statement and
- 6 if included may, in a later or amended statement, be shown as a
- 7 deduction, but adequate records of each instance shall be kept.
- 8 (c) The balance of cash on hand at the beginning and the end
- 9 of the period covered by the campaign statement.
- 10 (d) The total amount of contributions received during the
- 11 period covered by the campaign statement from persons who con-
- 12 tributed \$20.01 or more THAN \$20.00.
- (e) The total amount of contributions received during the
- 14 period covered by the campaign statement from persons who con-
- 15 tributed \$20.00 or less.
- 16 (f) The total amount of contributions of \$20.00 or less
- 17 received during the period covered by the campaign statement and
- 18 the cumulative amount of the contributions received by the filer
- 19 pursuant to section 41(3).
- 20 (q) The following information regarding each fund-raising
- 21 event shall be included in the report:
- 22 (i) The type of event, date held, address and name, if any,
- 23 of the place where the activity was held, and approximate number
- 24 of individuals participating or in attendance.
- 25 (ii) The total amount of all contributions of  $\frac{\$20.01}{\text{or}}$
- 26 more THAN \$20.00.

- 1 (iii) The total amount of all contributions of \$20.00 or 2 less.
- 3 (iv) The gross receipts of the fund-raising event.
- 4 (v) The expenditures incident to the event.
- 5 (h) The full name of each individual from whom contributions
- 6 totaling -\$20.01 or more THAN \$20.00 are received during the
- 7 period covered by the campaign statement, together with the
- 8 individual's street address, the amount contributed, the date on
- 9 which each contribution was received, and the cumulative amount
- 10 contributed by that individual. The occupation, employer, and
- 11 principal place of business shall be stated if the individual's
- 12 cumulative contributions are \$200.01 or more THAN \$200.00.
- (i) The cumulative amount contributed and the name and
- 14 address of each individual, except those individuals reported
- 15 under subdivision (h), who contributed a total of \$20.01 or
- 16 more THAN \$20.00. The occupation, employer, and principal place
- 17 of business, shall be stated for each individual who contributed
- 18 <del>\$200.01 or</del> more THAN \$200.00.
- (j) The name and street address of each person, other than
- 20 an individual, from whom contributions are received during the
- 21 period covered by the campaign statement, together with an item-
- 22 ization of the amounts contributed, the date on which each con-
- 23 tribution was received, and the cumulative amount contributed by
- 24 that person.
- 25 (k) The name, address, and amount given by an individual who
- 26 contributed \$20.01 or more THAN \$20.00 of the total amount
- 27 contributed by a person who is other than a committee or an

- 1 individual. The occupation, employer, and principal place of
- 2 business shall be stated if the individual contributed \$200.01
- 3 or more THAN \$200.00 of the total amount contributed by a person
- 4 who is other than a committee or an individual.
- 5 (l) The cumulative total of expenditures of \$50.00 or less
- 6 made during the period covered by the campaign statement except
- 7 for expenditures made to or on behalf of another committee, can-
- 8 didate, or ballot question.
- 9 (m) The full name and street address of each person to whom
- 10 expenditures totaling \$50.01 or more THAN \$50.00 were made,
- 11 together with the amount of each separate expenditure to each
- 12 such person during the period covered by the campaign statement;
- 13 the purpose of the expenditure; the full name and street address
- 14 of the person providing the consideration for which any expendi-
- 15 ture was made if different from the payee; the itemization
- 16 regardless of amount of each expenditure made to or on behalf of
- 17 another committee, candidate, or ballot question; and the cumula-
- 18 tive amount of expenditures for or against that candidate or
- 19 ballot question for an election cycle. An expenditure made in
- 20 support of more than 1 candidate or ballot question, or both,
- 21 shall be apportioned reasonably among the candidates or ballot
- 22 questions, or both.
- 23 (N) FOR A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE FOR A CANDIDATE FOR ELECTIVE
- 24 OFFICE, THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF CONTRIBUTIONS RECEIVED FROM INDEPEN-
- 25 DENT COMMITTEES AND POLITICAL COMMITTEES.
- 26 (2) A candidate committee or ballot question committee shall
- 27 report all cumulative amounts required by this section on a per

- 1 election cycle basis. Except for <del>subdivision (m)</del> SUBSECTION
- 2 (1)(M), an independent committee or political committee shall
- 3 report all cumulative amounts required by this section on a cal-
- 4 endar year basis.
