## **HOUSE BILL No. 5088**

August 22, 1991, Introduced by Rep. Bryant and referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Forestry and Minerals.

A bill to amend sections 514, 515, 517, 519, and 530 of Act No. 40 of the Public Acts of 1956, entitled as amended "The drain code of 1956,"

being sections 280.514, 280.515, 280.517, 280.519, and 280.530 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 514, 515, 517, 519, and 530 of Act
- 2 No. 40 of the Public Acts of 1956, being sections 280.514,
- 3 280.515, 280.517, 280.519, and 280.530 of the Michigan Compiled
- 4 Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 514. (1) There is hereby A DRAINAGE BOARD IS created
- 6 for each project petitioned for under the provisions of this
- 7 chapter. -, a THE drainage board -to SHALL consist of ALL OF
- 8 the FOLLOWING:

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- 1 (A) THE director of THE DEPARTMENT OF agriculture. and the
- 2 (B) THE drain commissioner of each county involved in the
- 3 project INCLUDED IN THE PRELIMINARY FINDING OF THE DIRECTOR OF
- 4 THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 517.
- 5 (C) THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF EACH PUBLIC CORPORATION,
- 6 OTHER THAN THIS STATE OR A COUNTY, INCLUDED IN THE PRELIMINARY
- 7 FINDING OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE UNDER
- 8 SECTION 517.
- 9 (2) The director of THE DEPARTMENT OF agriculture shall be
- 10 the chairman of said CHAIRPERSON OF THE DRAINAGE board. Said
- 11 THE DRAINAGE board shall select 1 of its members as secretary.
- 12 (3) THE DRAINAGE BOARD MAY PROVIDE COMPENSATION, MILEAGE,
- 13 AND EXPENSES FOR EACH CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A PUBLIC CORPO-
- 14 RATION SERVING ON THE DRAINAGE BOARD. HOWEVER, ANY COMPENSATION
- 15 SHALL NOT EXCEED \$25.00 PER DIEM, EXCLUDING MILEAGE AND EXPENSES,
- 16 FOR ATTENDING DRAINAGE BOARD MEETINGS.
- 17 Sec. 515. -There AN AUGMENTED DRAINAGE BOARD is created
- 18 for each project petitioned for under -the provisions of this
- 19 chapter. -, an THE augmented drainage board -to SHALL consist
- 20 of the members of the drainage board together with the chairman
- 21 CHAIRPERSON of the COUNTY board of supervisors COMMISSIONERS
- 22 and the -chairman CHAIRPERSON of the board of county auditors of
- 23 each county -involved INCLUDED IN THE PRELIMINARY FINDING OF THE
- 24 DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 517. If
- 25 there is no board of county auditors in -any- A county, then the
- 26 -chairman CHAIRPERSON of the finance committee of the COUNTY
- 27 board of supervisors COMMISSIONERS shall act as BE a member

- 1 of the augmented drainage board. -, and if IF there is neither a
- 2 board of county auditors nor A finance committee, then the
- 3 -chairman CHAIRPERSON of the COUNTY board of -supervisors-
- 4 COMMISSIONERS shall select 1 member of the COUNTY board of
- 5 supervisors of his county to act as COMMISSIONERS TO BE a
- 6 member of the augmented drainage board. The chairman
- 7 CHAIRPERSON and secretary of the drainage board shall -act as
- 8 chairman BE THE CHAIRPERSON and secretary, respectively, of the
- 9 augmented drainage board. The chairman of the board of supervi-
- 10 sors and any THE AUGMENTED DRAINAGE BOARD MAY PROVIDE COMPENSA-
- 11 TION, MILEAGE, AND EXPENSES FOR EACH CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A
- 12 PUBLIC CORPORATION SERVING ON THE AUGMENTED DRAINAGE BOARD BY
- 13 VIRTUE OF MEMBERSHIP ON THE DRAINAGE BOARD UNDER
- 14 SECTION 514(1)(C) AND EACH member of -a THE COUNTY board of
- 15 -supervisors COMMISSIONERS serving on the augmented drainage
- 16 board. shall receive such compensation, mileage and expenses as
- 17 shall be provided by the augmented drainage board except that
- 18 such HOWEVER, ANY compensation shall not exceed \$25.00 per diem,
- 19 exclusive of EXCLUDING mileage and expenses, for attendance
- 20 at ATTENDING augmented drainage board meetings.
- 21 Sec. 517. Upon receipt of a petition as hereinbefore
- 22 provided UNDER SECTION 513, the director of THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 23 agriculture shall make a preliminary finding of the -counties
- 24 which, in his opinion, include public corporations, OTHER THAN
- 25 COUNTIES OR THIS STATE, that should be assessed under the provi-
- 26 sions of this chapter for the cost of the proposed drain AND OF
- 27 THE COUNTIES THAT INCLUDE THOSE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS. Upon -the-

- 1 making <del>of such</del> THE preliminary finding, the director of THE
- 2 DEPARTMENT OF agriculture shall give notice of the time and place
- 3 of the first meeting of the drainage board and of the first meet-
- 4 ing of the augmented drainage board, by sending a copy of such
- 5 THE notice and of -such THE preliminary finding by registered
- 6 mail to each member, thereof, and to each highway agency having
- 7 jurisdiction over any A highway, road and OR street in said
- 8 THE district. -, which THE notice and finding shall be mailed
- 9 not less than 10 days prior to the time BEFORE THE DATE of the
- 10 meeting. In the event there be IF THERE IS no board of county
- 11 auditors or finance committee in any A county involved
- 12 INCLUDED IN THE PRELIMINARY FINDING OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE
- 13 DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, then notice to the chairman of the
- 14 board of supervisors of such county shall be deemed to be
- 15 CHAIRPERSON OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY
- 16 SERVES AS notice to the member of the COUNTY board of
- 17 -supervisors COMMISSIONERS to be selected by -him THE
- 18 CHAIRPERSON. The drainage board shall meet first, for the pur-
- 19 pose of selecting a secretary. Upon the selection of a secre-
- 20 tary, the director of THE DEPARTMENT OF agriculture shall turn
- 21 over to -such- THE secretary the original petition and any other
- 22 records in his OR HER office pertaining to the proposed drain.
- Sec. 519. (1) The augmented drainage board, at its first
- 24 meeting, shall consider the petition for the project and make a
- 25 tentative determination as to OF the sufficiency of the
- 26 petition, and the practicability of the proposed drain, and
- 27 further make a tentative determination of the public

- 1 corporations to be assessed. The augmented drainage board shall
- 2 give a name to the drain and to the drainage district. The dis-
- 3 trict shall be composed of the public corporations to be assessed
- 4 for the cost of the project.
- 5 (2) If the augmented drainage board, by resolution, tenta-
- 6 tively determines that there should be assessed a public corpora-
- 7 tion in a county other than those NOT contained in the tenta-
- 8 tive findings of the director of the department of agriculture,
- 9 further proceedings shall not be taken by the augmented drainage
- 10 board, but the resolution shall have the effect of amending the
- 11 preliminary finding of the director of the department of
- 12 agriculture. The director of the department of agriculture shall
- 13 proceed, as in the first instance, to call a new meeting of the
- 14 drainage board and the augmented drainage board as enlarged by
- 15 reason of the inclusion of the additional public corporations
- 16 in another county- CORPORATION.
- 17 (3) After the augmented drainage board has made the deter-
- 18 mination specified in this section MAKES A TENTATIVE DETERMINA-
- 19 TION UNDER SUBSECTION (1), it shall fix a time, date, and place
- 20 it will meet to hear objections to the proposed drain and the
- 21 petition for the drain, and the matter of assessing the cost of
- 22 the drain to the designated public corporations. Notice of the
- 23 hearing shall be published twice in each county -involved-
- 24 CONTAINING A PUBLIC CORPORATION PROPOSED TO BE ASSESSED FOR THE
- 25 COST OF THE DRAIN by inserting the notice in at least 1 newspaper
- 26 published in the county, designated by the augmented drainage
- 27 board. The first publication shall be made not less than 20 days

- 1 before the time of hearing. The notice shall also be sent by
- 2 registered mail to the clerk or secretary of each public corpora-
- 3 tion proposed to be assessed, except that a notice to the state
- 4 shall be sent to the -state highway director OF THE STATE TRANS-
- 5 PORTATION DEPARTMENT and a notice to a county shall be sent to
- 6 both the county clerk and the county road commission. The mail-
- 7 ing shall be made not less than 20 days before the time of
- 8 hearing. The notice shall be signed by the secretary and proof
- 9 of the publication and mailing of the notice shall be filed with
- 10 the secretary. The augmented drainage board may provide a form
- 11 to be substantially followed in the giving of -such THE notice.
- 12 (4) After the hearing, the augmented drainage board shall
- 13 make a determination as to the sufficiency of the petition, the
- 14 practicability of the drain, whether the drain should be con-
- 15 structed, the public corporations to be assessed, and shall issue
- 16 its order accordingly. The order shall be known as the final
- 17 order of determination. A public corporation shall not be elimi-
- 18 nated from, or added to, those tentatively determined to be
- 19 assessed without a rehearing after notice. After the augmented
- 20 drainage board has made the determinations, further action in
- 21 respect to the drain shall be taken by the drainage board. The
- 22 augmented drainage board may be reconvened by its chairperson or
- 23 2 members of the board, -upon AFTER notice IS given for the pur-
- 24 pose of making a correction or addition to its proceedings.
- 25 Sec. 530. (1) The drainage board for each project shall
- 26 continue in existence with -such changes in personnel -as shall
- 27 result THAT RESULT from changes in the offices of director of

- 1 THE DEPARTMENT OF agriculture, and drain commissioners DRAIN
- 2 COMMISSIONER, OR CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A PUBLIC CORPORATION
- 3 ASSESSED FOR THE DRAIN. It shall be THE DRAINAGE BOARD IS
- 4 responsible for the operation and maintenance of the drain. Any
- 5 necessary expenses incurred in administration and in the opera-
- 6 tion and maintenance of the drain and not covered by contract
- 7 shall be paid by the -several public corporations assessed for
- 8 the cost of the drain. The assessments shall be in the same pro-
- 9 portion as the cost of the drain was assessed unless the drainage
- 10 board establishes a different proportion for the assessments
- 11 after notice and hearing as provided in section 521.
- 12 (2) The drainage board, by resolution duly adopted by it,
- 13 may relinquish jurisdiction and control over -any- ALL OR part of
- 14 a drain or drain project at any time when there is no outstanding
- 15 indebtedness or contract liability of its drainage district, to
- 16 the county, township, city, or village in which the DRAIN OR
- 17 DRAIN PROJECT, OR THE part of the drain or drain project OVER
- 18 WHICH JURISDICTION AND CONTROL IS TO BE ASSUMED, is wholly
- 19 located, if the county, township, city, or village requests or
- 20 consents to the relinquishment of jurisdiction and control by
- 21 resolution duly adopted by its governing body. Indebtedness-
- 22 FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, INDEBTEDNESS or contract
- 23 liability of -any A drainage district -which THAT will be paid
- 24 in full at the time of consummation of relinquishment of juris-
- 25 diction and control -shall not be deemed IS NOT CONSIDERED to be
- 26 outstanding. If relinquishment of jurisdiction and control is to
- 27 a county, the resolution of the governing body of the county

- I shall specify the county agency, such as board of public works,
- 2 drain commissioner, board of county road commissioners, or parks
- 3 and recreation commission, -which THAT SUBSEQUENTLY shall be
- 4 thereafter responsible for exercise of such jurisdiction and
- 5 control. Any -moneys- MONEY in the drain fund of any drain, over
- 6 any part of which jurisdiction and control is relinquished, shall
- 7 be used to pay any indebtedness or contract liability of its
- 8 drainage district, and the balance shall be turned over to the
- 9 county, township, city, or village to be used solely with respect
- 10 to the drain, -all- or part -thereof OF THE DRAIN, over which
- 11 jurisdiction and control is assumed. If the relinquishment of
- 12 jurisdiction and control and the turnover of drain fund relates
- 13 to a part of a drain or drain project, such relinquishment and
- 14 turnover shall not become effective until consented to by resolu-
- 15 tion of the governing body of each public corporation which
- 16 THAT has paid a part of the cost of the drain or drain project,
- 17 and for this purpose the board of county road commissioners and
- 18 the state -highway TRANSPORTATION commission -shall be deemed-
- 19 ARE CONSIDERED to be the governing body BODIES for the county
- 20 and the state, RESPECTIVELY.
