- 9 (K) $\frac{-(2)}{(2)}$ A statement authorizing the cancellation of regis10 tration at the applicant's last place of registration.
- 11 (ℓ) $\overline{\text{(m)}}$ A space for the applicant to sign and certify to 12 the truth of the statements on the application.
- (2) The applicant shall sign the application. Upon receipt 14 of the application, the agent shall sign the application, stamp 15 the application with a validation stamp, and provide the applicant with a receipt verifying the registration application.
