A bill to amend section 675d of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended

"Michigan vehicle code,"

as added by Act No. 89 of the Public Acts of 1989, being section 257.675d of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1 Section 1. Section 675d of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts  
2 of 1949, as added by Act No. 89 of the Public Acts of 1989, being  
3 section 257.675d of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to  
4 read as follows:

5 Sec. 675d. (1) A law enforcement agency or a local unit of  
6 government may implement and administer a program to authorize  
7 and utilize persons other than police officers as volunteers to  
8 issue citations as described in sections 742 and 743 for  
9 violations of section 674(1)(s) or a local ordinance

1 substantially corresponding to section 674(1)(s). Before  
2 authorizing and utilizing persons other than police officers to  
3 issue citations, the law enforcement agency or local unit of gov-  
4 ernment shall implement a program to train the persons to prop-  
5 erly issue citations as provided in this section. A person who  
6 successfully completes a program of training implemented pursuant  
7 to this section may issue citations as provided in this section  
8 as authorized by the law enforcement agency or local unit of  
9 government.

10 (2) As used in this section:

11 (a) "Law enforcement agency" means a police agency of a  
12 city, village, or township; a sheriff's department; the depart-  
13 ment of state police; or any other governmental law enforcement  
14 agency in this state.

15 (b) "Local unit of government" means a STATE UNIVERSITY OR  
16 COLLEGE, county, city, village, or township.

17 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
18 Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 5411 (request  
19 no. 03561'91) of the 86th Legislature is enacted into law.
