"An act to provide immunity from civil action to members of the legislature of this state for acts done pursuant to duty as legislators; to prohibit members of the legislature of this state from being made parties to contested cases or other administrative proceedings for acts done pursuant to duty as legislators; and to provide for certain exemptions from subpoenas,"

being section 4.553 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 3 of Act No. 27 of the Public Acts of
2 1984, being section 4.553 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 3. A member of the legislature shall not be subject to 5 a subpoena for any matter involving statements made by OR TO the 6 legislator pursuant to his or her duty as a legislator.
