A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4302 AS INTRODUCED 2-18-93

Public Act 278 of 1909, the act governing the incorporation of villages, provides certain exceptions to the general rule that prohibits a village from incurring indebtedness. The bill would amend the act to include combined sewer overflow abatement facility bonds under the list of exceptions. The bill would also amend the act to specify that a village may acquire land outside its corporate limits to dispose of sewage or to obtain or protect a village water supply, provided that its proposed use would not materially injure the health or safety of those living adjacent to the land. The acquisition may be made by purchase or condemnation proceedings.
