A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4381 AS INTRODUCED 2-25-93

Currently, notaries public are appointed by the governor for four-year terms. The bill would amend the act, titled "Of County Officers" (Section 107 of Chapter 14 of the Revised Statutes of 1846) to say that notaries public would be appointed "until their birthday occurring not more than 4 years after the date of their appointment." As is currently the case, the governor could remove a notary public's commission at any time.
