RECYCLING SCRAP TIRES

A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4691 AS INTRODUCED 5-4-93

House Bill 4691 would amend the Scrap Tire Regulatory Act to require retailers and manufacturers to accept scrap tires in exchange for tires that have been sold to consumers. Under the bill, a retailer would be required to accept a scrap tire without charge when selling a consumer a tire. The retailer would dispose of scrap tires at a collection site, or else return the tire to its manufacturer. The manufacturer would be required to accept scrap tires from retailers, also without charge, in an amount equal to the number of tires the manufacturer had sold to each retailer.
