A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4894 AS INTRODUCED 6-29-93

The bill would amend the Michigan Penal Code to make it a misdemeanor to harass, injure, attempt to injure, or interfere with a leader dog for a blind person, a hearing dog for a deaf or hearing impaired person, or a service dog for a physically limited person. The offense would be punishable by up to 90 days in jail, a fine of up to \$100, or both.
