

HOUSE BILL No. 4048

February 2, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Joe Young, Jr. and referred to the Committee on Agriculture and Forestry.

A bill to amend the title and sections 2, 4, 5, 14, and 16 of Act No. 70 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled "Seal of quality act," being sections 289.632, 289.634, 289.635, 289.644, and 289.646 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. The title and sections 2, 4, 5, 14, and 16 of 2 Act No. 70 of the Public Acts of 1961, being sections 289.632, 3 289.634, 289.635, 289.644, and 289.646 of the Michigan Compiled 4 Laws, are amended to read as follows:

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TITLE

6 An act to promote the development and to encourage consump-7 tion of Michigan agricultural AND SEAFOOD products by use of a 8 seal denoting quality; to prescribe the powers and duties of the 9 state department of agriculture; to establish procedures for

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1 standards; to provide for fees; to authorize the appointment of
2 -commodity CERTAIN committees; and to prescribe penalties. -for
3 violations.-

4 Sec. 2. As used in this act:

5 (A) "AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT" MEANS AN AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT 6 GROWN, PACKED, AND PROCESSED WITHIN THIS STATE.

7 (B) -(a) "Commission" means the commission of agriculture.
8 (C) -(b) "Department" means the -state department of
9 agriculture.

10 (D) -(c) "Director" means the state director of THE
11 DEPARTMENT OF agriculture.

(E) -(d) "Person" means -individuals, partnerships, trusts,
13 associations, corporations, and any and all other business units,
14 devices and arrangements, or receiver, trustee or assignee of
15 such business units AN INDIVIDUAL, PARTNERSHIP, CORPORATION,
16 ASSOCIATION, OR OTHER LEGAL ENTITY.

(F) (e) "Michigan seal of quality" means any label, tag, or other device bearing the official emblem promulgated under the provisions of this act containing the term "Michigan seal of quality" attached to, affixed, or placed upon any crate, carton, package, or other container of agricultural products grown, packed and processed within this state OR SEAFOOD PRODUCTS.

24 (f) "Products" mean agricultural products grown, packed and 25 processed within this state. (G) "SEAFOOD PRODUCT" MEANS FISH OR OTHER SEAFOOD FOUND IN 2 LAKE MICHIGAN, LAKE HURON, LAKE SUPERIOR, OR LAKE ERIE OR A 3 CONNECTING WATERWAY.

Sec. 4. Upon the request of any commodity group of produc-5 ers of AN agricultural -products stating PRODUCT OR GROUP OF 6 PRODUCERS OF A SEAFOOD PRODUCT that BELIEVES it is essential to 7 the successful marketing of the -products - PRODUCT that standards 8 of quality be established FOR THAT PRODUCT, the commission, after 9 not less than 10 days' notice, shall call a public hearing at 10 which any interested person shall have the right to be heard AFTER RECEIVING TESTIMONY, the 12 commission shall determine whether the establishment of standards 13 of guality for the -products - AGRICULTURAL OR SEAFOOD PRODUCT is 14 necessary to the successful marketing -thereof OF THE PRODUCT. The commission, if it determines that it is neces-Sec. 5. 15 16 sary to establish standards of quality for any -products-17 AGRICULTURAL OR SEAFOOD PRODUCT, shall promulgate an order estab-18 lishing standards of guality for the products, which PRODUCT. 19 THE standards shall -relate INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED to, the 10 quality, size, and condition - thereof OF THE PRODUCT, AS **!1 APPROPRIATE.**

Sec. 14. The commission shall enforce this act and may spromulgate, -such orders, rules and regulations in accordance with Act No. 88 of the Public Acts of 1943, as amended, being sections 24.71 to 24.82 of the Compiled Laws of 1948, and subject to Act No. 197 of the Public Acts of 1952, as amended, being

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1 necessary to carry out the purposes of this act AS NECESSARY, 2 RULES TO IMPLEMENT THIS ACT PURSUANT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCE-3 DURES ACT OF 1969, ACT NO. 306 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1969, BEING 4 SECTIONS 24.201 TO 24.328 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS. When 5 the director $-\tau$ or any person appointed by him τ OR HER deter-6 mines that <u>products</u> AN AGRICULTURAL OR SEAFOOD PRODUCT bearing 7 the seal <u>fail</u> FAILS to conform to the quality characteristics 8 and standards promulgated by the commission, the director or his 9 OR HER appointee may seize and dispose of the products as pro-10 vided by section 7 of Act No. 211 of the Public Acts of 1893, as 11 amended, being section 289.37 of the MICHIGAN Compiled Laws. <u>of</u> 12 1948.

Sec. 16. The commission, after adopting rules to implement 13 14 this act, shall establish commodity AND SEAFOOD committees to 15 disseminate information relative to the purposes of this act and 16 to report to the commission -in-reference to the functioning 17 thereof - CONCERNING THE COMMITTEE'S WORK. Commodity AND SEAFOOD 18 committees shall consist of representatives of producers, first 19 handlers, wholesalers, retailers, and consumers capable of being 20 recognized as representative of the specific commodity OR SEAFOOD 21 interests involved by that industry. The commission may estab-22 lish committees for any specific commodity OR SEAFOOD when 23 requested to do so by any representative segment of that 24 - commodity industry. The commission shall create a central com-25 mittee representative of all commodity AND SEAFOOD committees and 26 of such other governmental agencies as may have interests in 27 furthering the purposes of this $act - \mu$ upon the request of 3

1 existing <u>commodity</u> committees. The members of all committees 2 shall be that number determined and approved by the commission. 3 The members of committees shall hold office for a period of 1 4 year. The commission may reappoint any member of any committee. 5 The per diem compensation of committee members and the schedule 6 for reimbursement of expenses shall be established annually by 7 the legislature.

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
