A bill to amend section 267 of Act No. 431 of the Public

Acts of 1984, entitled as amended

"The management and budget act,"

being section 18.1267 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 267 of Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of
 1984, being section 18.1267 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
 3 amended to read as follows:

Sec. 267. (1) The department shall issue directives to pro-5 vide for the disclosure, transfer, and disposal of surplus, sal-6 vage, and scrap material of state agencies. The department may 7 dispose of surplus, -and of- salvage, or scrap by -donating- ANY 8 OF THE FOLLOWING MEANS:

9 (A) DONATING or selling the <u>property or equipment</u> MATERIAL 10 to a unit of local government. or by selling

(B) SELLING the -surplus, salvage, or scrap MATERIAL at
 2 auction.

3 (C) DONATING OR SELLING THE MATERIAL TO A SHELTER FOR HOME4 LESS PERSONS, FOOD KITCHEN, FOOD BANK, OR OTHER ENTITY WHOSE PRI5 MARY PURPOSE IS TO PROVIDE OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATION, FOOD, OR
6 MEALS FOR INDIGENT INDIVIDUALS, IF A CONTRIBUTION TO THAT ENTITY
7 IS TAX DEDUCTIBLE FOR THE DONOR UNDER THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.
8 (2) The department may pay necessary costs incurred in the
9 conduct of the transfers or auctions of the <u>property or</u>
10 equipment- MATERIAL, including the necessary warehousing and
11 reconditioning costs, from the proceeds of the auction or by
12 assessing a handling fee for <u>property or equipment</u> THE MATERIAL
13 being donated.
