

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4240**

February 11, 1993, Introduced by Reps. McBryde, Goschka, Hoffman, Rocca, Kukuk, Lowe, London, Hill, Jamian, Weeks, Horton, Galloway, Whyman, Bullard, Bodem, Gernaat, Walberg, Nye, McManus, Porreca, Dolan, Fitzgerald, Hammerstrom, Jersevic, Llewellyn, Brackenridge, Gnodtke, Dalman, Middaugh, Cropsey, Sikkema, Dobb, Gustafson, Gilmer, Shugars, Bankes, Martin, Johnson, Stille, Munsell and Middleton and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 316 of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled as amended
"The Michigan penal code,"
as amended by Act No. 28 of the Public Acts of 1980, being section 750.316 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 316 of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 2 1931, as amended by Act No. 28 of the Public Acts of 1980, being 3 section 750.316 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read 4 as follows:
- Sec. 316. Murder which THAT is perpetrated by means of
- 6 poison, lying in wait, or other -wilful WILLFUL, deliberate, and
- 7 premeditated killing, or which THAT is committed in the
- 8 perpetration OF, or attempt to perpetrate, arson, criminal sexual
- 9 conduct in the first or third degree, CHILD ABUSE IN THE FIRST

- 1 DEGREE, A FELONY VIOLATION OF PART 74 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE,
- 2 ACT NO. 368 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1978, BEING SECTIONS 333.7401
- 3 TO 333.7461 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, robbery, breaking and
- 4 entering of a dwelling, larceny of any kind, extortion, or kid-
- 5 napping, is murder of the first degree, and shall be punished by
- 6 imprisonment for life.
