

HOUSE BILL No. 4327

February 23, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Jondahl, DeMars, Rivers, Brown, Gustafson, Hollister and Pitoniak and referred to the Committee on Public Retirement.

A bill to amend sections 17h and 17i of Act No. 240 of the Public Acts of 1943, entitled as amended "State employees' retirement act," as amended by Act No. 241 of the Public Acts of 1987, being sections 38.17h and 38.17i of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Sections 17h and 17i of Act No. 240 of the
 Public Acts of 1943, as amended by Act No. 241 of the Public Acts
 of 1987, being sections 38.17h and 38.17i of the Michigan
 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

5 Sec. 17h. (1) A member may elect to purchase service credit 6 for -not-more than 5 years of full time- service as an employee 7 with a city, county, township, or village of this state, upon 8 request and presentation of documentation of the employment 9 rendered -which- THAT is verifiable from official employment

1 records, which may be substantiated by federal wage statements. 2 or other acceptable documentation as determined by the retirement 3 board. -, and upon payment to the board of THE MEMBER SHALL PAY 4 TO THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM an amount -which- THAT is equal to the 5 actuarial cost multiplied by the member's full-time or equated 6 full-time fiscal year compensation for the fiscal year in which 7 payment is made multiplied by each year and fraction of a year of 8 service to be purchased, up to -the maximum 5 YEARS OF SERVICE 9 CREDIT. For the purpose of computing payment under this subsec-10 tion, the compensation amount used shall not be less than the 11 highest full-time or equated full-time fiscal year compensation 12 previously received by the member as a member of the RETIREMENT THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM SHALL PRORATE SERVICE AS AN 13 system. 14 EMPLOYEE WITH A CITY, COUNTY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE OF THIS STATE 15 THAT IS OTHER THAN FULL-TIME SERVICE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHAS-16 ING SERVICE CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION.

17 (2) Service credit purchased under this section shall not be
18 used to satisfy the minimum number of years of service credit
19 required to receive a retirement allowance under this act.

20 (3) Service credit purchased under this section -shall IS
21 not -be- creditable toward retirement under this act if the
22 member is or was eligible to receive a pension or annuity for the
23 same service from another retirement system.

(4) If a member who made payment under this section dies and
25 a retirement allowance is not payable or if the member leaves
26 service with -the- THIS state before his or her retirement
27 allowance becomes effective, the payment made by the member shall

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1 be refunded upon request to the member, to the person designated 2 by the member in writing to the <u>board</u> RETIREMENT SYSTEM, or if 3 a person is not designated, then to the member's legal represen-4 tative OR ESTATE.

Sec. 17i. (1) A member may elect to purchase service credit 5 6 for -not more than 5 years of full time service with the federal 7 government, or as a state employee with another state, upon 8 request and presentation of documentation of the employment 9 rendered -which- THAT is verifiable from official federal or 10 state government retirement system records or other acceptable 11 documentation as determined by the retirement board. -, and upon 12 payment to the board of THE MEMBER SHALL PAY TO THE RETIREMENT 13 SYSTEM an amount which- THAT is equal to the actuarial cost 14 multiplied by the member's full-time or equated full-time fiscal 15 year compensation for the fiscal year in which payment is made 16 multiplied by each year and fraction of a year of service to be 17 purchased, up to the maximum 5 YEARS OF SERVICE CREDIT. For 18 the purpose of computing payment under this subsection, the com-19 pensation amount used shall not be less than the highest fiscal 20 year compensation previously received by the member as a member 21 of the system. A member may not purchase service credit under 22 this section for service with the federal government that may be 23 purchased under section 18. THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM SHALL PRORATE 24 SERVICE WITH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OR AS A STATE EMPLOYEE WITH 25 ANOTHER STATE THAT IS OTHER THAN FULL-TIME SERVICE FOR THE PUR-26 POSE OF PURCHASING SERVICE CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION.

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(2) Service credit purchased under this section shall not be
 used to satisfy the minimum number of years of service credit
 required to receive a retirement allowance under this act.

4 (3) Service credit purchased under this section -shall IS
5 not -be- creditable toward retirement under this act if the
6 member is eligible to receive a pension or annuity for the same
7 service from another retirement system.

8 (4) If a member who made payment under this section dies and 9 a retirement allowance is not payable or if the member leaves 10 service with the THIS state before his or her retirement allow-11 ance becomes effective, the payment made by the member shall be 12 refunded upon request to the member, to the person designated by 13 the member in writing to the <u>board</u> RETIREMENT SYSTEM, or if a 14 person is not designated, then to the member's legal representa-15 tive OR ESTATE.

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
