

HOUSE BILL No. 4641

April 22, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Gubow and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 1e of chapter IV of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended
"The code of criminal procedure,"
as added by Act No. 506 of the Public Acts of 1980, being section 764.1e of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 1e of chapter IV of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts of 1927, as added by Act No. 506 of the Public Acts of 1980, being section 764.1e of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 CHAPTER IV
- Sec. 1e. (1) For purposes of sections 1a to 1d of this

 7 chapter, a complaint signed by a peace officer shall be treated

- 9 above the date and signature of the officer:
- "I declare under the penalties of perjury that the state-
- 11 ments above are true to the best of my information, knowledge,
- 12 and belief."
- 13 (2) A peace officer who -, knowing the statement is false.
- 14 KNOWINGLY makes a materially false statement in a complaint
- 15 signed pursuant to subsection (1) is -quilty EACH OF THE
- 16 FOLLOWING:
- 17 (A) GUILTY of perjury, a felony punishable by imprisonment
- 18 for not more than 15 years. -, and in addition, is in
- (B) IN contempt of court.
