

HOUSE BILL No. 4696

May 4, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Harrison, Varga, DeMars, Rivers, Jondahl and Jacobetti and referred to the Committee on Civil Rights and Women's Issues.

A bill to amend Act No. 453 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended

"Elliott-Larsen civil rights act,"

as amended, being sections 37.2101 to 37.2804 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 202a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Act No. 453 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
- 2 amended, being sections 37.2101 to 37.2804 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 202a to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 SEC. 202A. (1) EACH STATE DEPARTMENT SHALL INSURE THAT
- 6 MINORITY OWNED AND WOMEN OWNED BUSINESSES ARE GIVEN EQUAL PARTIC-
- 7 IPATION OPPORTUNITIES IN ALL DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES THAT DEAL WITH
- 8 PRIVATE SECTOR BUSINESSES.

- 1 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 2 (A) "MINORITY OWNED BUSINESS" MEANS A PARTNERSHIP,
- 3 CORPORATION, OR JOINT VENTURE OF ANY KIND THAT IS OWNED AND CON-
- 4 TROLLED BY A MEMBER OF A DISADVANTAGED GROUP INCLUDING, BUT NOT
- 5 LIMITED TO, BLACKS, NATIVE AMERICANS, HISPANICS, AND ASIANS.
- 6 (B) "WOMAN OWNED BUSINESS" MEANS A PARTNERSHIP, CORPORATION,
- 7 OR JOINT VENTURE OF ANY KIND THAT IS OWNED AND CONTROLLED BY A
- 8 WOMAN.
