# HOUSE BILL No. 4777 

May 12, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Curtis, Clack, Harder, Bobier, Scott, Freeman, Stille, Emerson and McNutt and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend sections 255, 257, 258, 261, 262, 263, and 264 of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1954, entitled "Michigan election law," being sections $168.255,168.257,168.258,168.261,168.262$, 168.263, and 168.264 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
the people of the state of michigan enact: 1 Section 1. Sections 255, 257, 258, 261, 262, 263, and 264 2 of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1954, being sections 3 168.255, 168.257, 168.258, 168.261, 168.262, 168.263, and 168.264 4 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows: 5 Sec. 255. When-any IF A PERSON WHO HAS QUALIFIED AS A 6 candidate of a political party for the office of county road com7 missioner Tafter having qualified as a candite, shall die,

If for anymeason there is no candidate ARE 17 FEWER CANDIDATES of a political party for county road commis18 sioner, a-blank-space- THAN THERE ARE PERSONS TO BE ELECTED IN 19 THAT ELECTION, THERE shall be provided on each of the official 20 primary ballots which $W 1 \pm$ A SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF BLANK SPACES 21 TO afford every elector of said THAT party IN THE COUNTY an 22 opportunity to vote for a candidate for such office THE SAME 23 NUMBER OF CANDIDATES FOR THE OFFICE AS THERE ARE PERSONS TO BE 24 ELECTED by writing in the name of his or her selection or by the 25 use of a slip or paster.

26 Sec. 258. The candidate CANDIDATES of each political 27 party for the office of county road commissioner, EQUAL IN NUMBER

1 TO THE NUMBER OF PERSONS TO BE ELECTED TO THAT OFFICE IN THAT
2 ELECTION, receiving the greatest number of votes cast for candi3 dates for THAT office, as set forth in the report of the 4 board of county canvassers, based on the returns from the various 5 election precincts, or as determined by THE board as the 6 result of a recount, shall be declared the nominee NOMINEES of 7 that political party for said THAT office at the next ensuing 8 November election, and the board of county canvassers shall

9 forthwith IMMEDIATELY certify -such nomination THE NOMINATIONS 10 to the county election commission.

11 Sec. 261. A county COUNTY road Commissioner
12 COMMISSIONERS shall be elected at the general election. to be
13 hezd on the-Puesday-succeeding the-firgt-Monday of November in
14 every even numbered year.
15 Sec. 262. The board of county canvassers shall determine
16 Which candidate THE CANDIDATES for county road commissioner,
17 EQUAL IN NUMBER TO THE NUMBER OF PERSONS TO BE ELECTED, WHO
18 received the greatest number of votes and shall declare sueh 19 candidate THE CANDIDATES to be duly elected. The board 20 shall forthwith IMMEDIATELY make and subscribe on its statement 21 of returns a certificate of such THE determination and deliver 22 the-same- IT to the county clerk.

Sec. 263. The county clerk shall file in his OR HER office 24 and preserve the original statement and determination of the 25 board of county canvassers of the results of the election and

The term of office for county road commissioner 4 COMMISSIONERS ELECTED BEFORE THE 1994 GENERAL NOVEMBER ELECTION 5 shall be 6 years. , beginning THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR COUNTY 6 ROAD COMMISSIONERS ELECTED AFTER THE 1992 GENERAL NOVEMBER ELEC7 TION SHALL BE 4 YEARS. THE TERM OF OFFICE OF A COUNTY ROAD COM-

8 MISSIONER SHALL BEGIN on the first day of January next following 9 his OR HER election, and shall continue until a successor that 10 have been IS elected and qualified.

11 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
12 Senate Bill No. $\qquad$ or House Bill No. 4778 (request
