

## HOUSE BILL No. 4883

June 23, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Joe Young, Jr. and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend sections 301 and 302 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended "Revised judicature act of 1961," as amended by Act No. 279 of the Public Acts of 1986, being sections 600.301 and 600.302 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add sections 301a and 303d.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Sections 301 and 302 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, as amended by Act No. 279 of the Public Acts of 1986, being sections 600.301 and 600.302 of the Michigan 4 Compiled Laws, are amended and sections 301a and 303d are added 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 301. The court of appeals shall consist of  $\frac{24}{2}$  27 judges and is a court of record.

- 1 SEC. 301A. NOT LATER THAN MARCH 1, 1994 AND THEREAFTER NOT
- 2 LATER THAN JANUARY 1 OF THE FIRST YEAR FOLLOWING THE RELEASE OF
- 3 THE FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS IN WHICH A GENERAL NOVEMBER ELECTION
- 4 IS HELD, THE LEGISLATURE SHALL PREPARE AN APPORTIONMENT AND
- 5 REDISTRICTING PLAN FOR THE COURT OF APPEALS ACCORDING TO THE FOL-
- 6 LOWING GUIDELINES:
- 7 (A) ALL DISTRICTS SHALL BE CONTIGUOUS, SINGLE-JUDGE
- 8 DISTRICTS.
- 9 (B) EACH DISTRICT SHALL HAVE A POPULATION NOT EXCEEDING 105%
- 10 AND NOT LESS THAN 95% OF THE IDEAL DISTRICT SIZE.
- 11 (C) ALL ELECTION DISTRICTS SHALL BE DRAWN IN COMPLIANCE WITH
- 12 THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 2 OF TITLE I OF THE VOTING RIGHTS ACT
- 13 OF 1965, AS AMENDED, PUBLIC LAW 89-110, 42 U.S.C. 1973. IN THE
- 14 APPLICATION OF THAT REQUIREMENT, IF IT IS POSSIBLE TO CREATE A
- 15 CONTIGUOUS MINORITY-MAJORITY DISTRICT WITH A POPULATION WITHIN 5%
- 16 OF THE IDEAL DISTRICT'S POPULATION, THAT DISTRICT SHALL BE
- 17 CREATED. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "MINORITY-MAJORITY DISTRICT"
- 18 MEANS A DISTRICT IN WHICH 65% OF THE POPULATION IS COMPOSED OF A
- 19 MINORITY GROUP'S MEMBERS AND 60% OF THE VOTING AGE POPULATION IS
- 20 COMPOSED OF MINORITY GROUP MEMBERS, ABSENT A SHOWING BY A PREPON-
- 21 DERANCE OF THE EVIDENCE THAT A LOWER OR GREATER PERCENTAGE WILL
- 22 ENABLE MINORITY VOTERS TO ELECT A JUDICIAL CANDIDATE OF THEIR
- 23 CHOICE.
- 24 (D) COURT OF APPEALS ELECTION DISTRICT LINES, WITH THE
- 25 EXCEPTION OF THOSE DRAWN TO CREATE THE MINORITY-MAJORITY DIS-
- 26 TRICTS UNDER SUBDIVISION (C), SHALL PRESERVE COUNTY LINES WITH

- 1 THE LEAST COST TO THE PRINCIPLE OF CREATING DISTRICTS WITH EQUAL 2 POPULATION.
- 3 (E) IF IT IS NECESSARY TO BREAK COUNTY LINES TO COMPLY WITH
- 4 SUBDIVISION (B) OR TO CREATE A MINORITY-MAJORITY DISTRICT UNDER
- 5 SUBDIVISION (C), THE PLAN SHALL SHIFT THE FEWEST WHOLE CITIES OR
- 6 WHOLE TOWNSHIPS NECESSARY. AS BETWEEN 2 CITIES OR TOWNSHIPS, THE
- 7 SHIFTING OF EITHER OF WHICH WOULD BRING THE DISTRICTS INTO COM-
- 8 PLIANCE WITH SUBDIVISION (B) OR (C), THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP WITH
- 9 THE LEAST POPULATION SHALL BE SHIFTED.
- (F) WITHIN THOSE COUNTIES TO WHICH THERE IS APPORTIONED MORE
- 11 THAN 1 COURT OF APPEALS JUDGE, ELECTION DISTRICT LINES, WITH THE
- 12 EXCEPTION OF THOSE DRAWN TO CREATE MINORITY-MAJORITY DISTRICTS
- 13 UNDER SUBDIVISION (C), SHALL BE DRAWN ON CITY AND TOWNSHIP LINES
- 14 WITH THE LEAST COST TO THE PRINCIPLE OF CREATING DISTRICTS OF
- 15 EQUAL POPULATION CONSISTENT WITH THE MAXIMUM PRESERVATION OF CITY
- 16 AND TOWNSHIP LINES, AND WITHOUT VIOLATING SUBDIVISION (B).
- 17 (G) IF IT IS NECESSARY TO BREAK CITY OR TOWNSHIP LINES TO
- 18 COMPLY WITH SUBDIVISION (B) OR TO CREATE A MINORITY-MAJORITY DIS-
- 19 TRICT UNDER SUBDIVISION (C), THE PLAN SHALL SHIFT THE NUMBER OF
- 20 PEOPLE NECESSARY TO ACHIEVE POPULATION EQUALITY BETWEEN THE 2
- 21 ELECTION DISTRICTS AFFECTED BY THE SHIFT, EXCEPT THAT INSTEAD OF
- 22 ABSOLUTE EQUALITY THE LINES MAY BE DRAWN ALONG THE CLOSEST STREET
- 23 OR COMPARABLE BOUNDARY.
- 24 (H) WITHIN A CITY OR TOWNSHIP TO WHICH THERE IS APPORTIONED
- 25 MORE THAN 1 COURT OF APPEALS JUDGE, ELECTION DISTRICT LINES, WITH
- 26 THE EXCEPTION OF THOSE DRAWN TO CREATE A MINORITY-MAJORITY
- 27 DISTRICT UNDER SUBDIVISION (C), SHALL BE DRAWN TO ACHIEVE THE

- 1 MAXIMUM COMPACTNESS POSSIBLE WITHIN A POPULATION RANGE OF 98% TO
- 2 102% OF ABSOLUTE EQUALITY BETWEEN DISTRICTS WITHIN THAT CITY OR
- 3 TOWNSHIP. COMPACTNESS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY CIRCUMSCRIBING EACH
- 4 DISTRICT WITHIN A CIRCLE OF MINIMUM RADIUS AND MEASURING THE
- 5 AREA, EXCLUDING ANY PART OF THE GREAT LAKES OR ANOTHER STATE,
- 6 INSIDE THE CIRCLE BUT NOT INSIDE THE DISTRICT.
- 7 (I) WHERE A DISCONTIGUOUS TOWNSHIP ISLAND EXISTS WITHIN AN
- 8 INCORPORATED CITY OR DISCONTIGUOUS PORTIONS OF TOWNSHIPS ARE
- 9 SPLIT BY AN INCORPORATED CITY, THE SPLITTING OF THE TOWNSHIP
- 10 SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED A SPLIT IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING CIRCUM-
- 11 STANCES EXIST:
- 12 (i) THE CITY MUST BE SPLIT BECAUSE OTHERWISE THAT ALLOWABLE
- 13 DIVERGENCE PROVIDED FOR IN SUBDIVISION (B) WOULD BE EXCEEDED AND
- 14 IT IS PRACTICABLE TO KEEP THE TOWNSHIP TOGETHER WITHIN 1
- 15 DISTRICT.
- 16 (ii) A TOWNSHIP ISLAND IS CONTAINED WITHIN A WHOLE CITY AND
- 17 A SPLIT OF THE CITY WOULD BE REQUIRED TO KEEP THE TOWNSHIP
- 18 INTACT.
- 19 (iii) THE DISCONTIGUOUS PORTION OF A TOWNSHIP CANNOT BE
- 20 INCLUDED IN THE SAME DISTRICT WITH ANOTHER PORTION OF THE SAME
- 21 TOWNSHIP WITHOUT CREATING A NONCONTIGUOUS DISTRICT.
- 22 Sec. 302. For the election of judges, the state shall be
- 23 divided into -3 27 judicial districts. Districts 1, 2, and 3
- 24 shall be entitled to elect 8 judges for their respective
- 25 districts. The districts shall be constituted and numbered as
