THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 27a of Act No. 206 of the Public Acts of
1893, as added by Act No. 539 of the Public Acts of 1982, being
section 211.27a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
as follows:

5 Sec. 27a. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection 6 (2), property shall be assessed at 50% of its true cash value 7 pursuant to section 3 of article -9- IX of the state constitution 8 of 1963 THROUGH DECEMBER 30, 1993 AND 40% OF ITS TRUE CASH VALUE 9 AFTER DECEMBER 30, 1993.

1 (2) Assessment of property, as required in this section and 2 section 27, shall be inapplicable to the assessment of property 3 subject to the levy of ad valorem taxes within voted tax limita-4 tion increases to pay principal and interest on limited tax bonds 5 issued by any governmental unit, including a county, township, 6 community college district, or school district, before January 1, 7 1964, if the assessment required to be made under this act would 8 be less than the assessment as state equalized prevailing on the 9 property at the time of the issuance of the bonds. This inappli-10 cability shall continue until levy of taxes to pay principal and 11 interest on the bonds is no longer required. The assessment of 12 property required by this act shall be applicable for all other 13 purposes.
