

HOUSE BILL No. 5066

September 29, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Gagliardi and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend the title and sections 3 and 6 of Act No. 39 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled

"An act to authorize local units of government to appropriate funds for purposes of providing activities or services to older persons, to authorize local units of government to levy taxes for services to older persons, and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

section 6 as amended by Act No. 41 of the Public Acts of 1982, being sections 400.573 and 400.576 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal certain parts of the act.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. The title and sections 3 and 6 of Act No. 39 of
- 2 the Public Acts of 1976, section 6 as amended by Act No. 41 of
- 3 the Public Acts of 1982, being sections 400.573 and 400.576 of
- 4 the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

1 TITLE

- 2 An act to authorize local units of government to appropriate
- 3 funds for purposes of providing activities or services to older
- 4 persons OR ACQUIRING LAND, BUILDINGS, OR FACILITIES FOR SUCH
- 5 ACTIVITIES OR SERVICES; AND to authorize local units of govern-
- 6 ment to levy taxes for services to older persons, and to repeal
- 7 certain acts and parts of acts THESE PURPOSES.
- 8 Sec. 3. A local unit of government may appropriate funds
- 9 to public or private nonprofit corporations or organizations for
- 10 -the purposes of planning EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- (A) PLANNING, coordinating, evaluating, and providing serv-
- 12 ices to older persons.
- 13 (B) ACQUIRING LAND AND CONSTRUCTING BUILDINGS AND OTHER
- 14 FACILITIES TO BE USED FOR A PURPOSE LISTED IN SUBDIVISION (A).
- 15 Sec. 6. (1) A governing body of a local unit of government
- 16 may submit OR, UPON VERIFICATION BY THE CLERK OF THE LOCAL UNIT
- 17 OF GOVERNMENT OF A PETITION DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION, SHALL
- 18 SUBMIT a millage proposition to the electorate to levy up to 1
- 19 mill for services to older citizens. -This- A PETITION SHALL BE
- 20 FILED WITH THE CLERK OF THE LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT AND SIGNED
- 21 BY A NUMBER OF ELECTORS OF THE LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT EQUAL TO
- 22 NOT LESS THAN 10% OF THE NUMBER OF ELECTORS OF THE LOCAL UNIT OF
- 23 GOVERNMENT WHO VOTED FOR GOVERNOR AT THE LAST GENERAL ELECTION AT
- 24 WHICH A GOVERNOR WAS ELECTED.
- 25 (2) THE MILLAGE proposition may be submitted at any election
- 26 held by the local unit of government, but shall not be submitted
- 27 at a special election of the local unit of government called

- 1 solely for the purpose of submitting -this THE millage
- 2 proposition.
- 3 Section 2. Section 7 of Act No. 39 of the Public Acts of
- 4 1976, being section 400.577 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 5 repealed.
