



HOUSE BILL No. 5082

October 7, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Gilmer, Allen, Sikkema, Richard A. Young, O'Neill and Jacobetti and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of natural resources and for capital outlay purposes for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994; to provide for certain work projects; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of natural
2 resources and for capital outlay purposes to supplement former appropria-
3 tions for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, from the following

20 CAPITAL OUTLAY

21 Sec. 601. The department of natural resources shall annually report
22 to the governor, the house and senate appropriations committees, the
23 house and senate appropriations subcommittees on natural resources, the
24 joint capital outlay subcommittee, the house and senate standing
25 committees on natural resources, and the house and senate fiscal agencies

1 the progress of state park recreation bond projects for which
2 appropriations have been made under this act. This report shall include
3 a list of bond funded actions taken on each project; other sources of
4 funds used in addition to bond proceeds, including private actions; the
5 amount of funds expended for each project; further actions anticipated on
6 each project; and other information considered pertinent by the depart-
7 ment of natural resources.

8 Sec. 602. The unexpended portion of the appropriation in this act
9 for state park recreation bond projects shall be considered a work
10 project and shall not lapse to the recreation bond fund but shall con-
11 tinue to be available for the purpose for which it was appropriated.
