



HOUSE BILL No. 5245

December 17, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Middaugh, Alley, Gnodtke, Mathieu, Bodem, Llewellyn, Yokich, Byrum, Wetters, Freeman, Shepich, Clack, McNutt, Munsell, Dobb, Randall, Bender and Profit and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend Act No. 149 of the Public Acts of 1960,
entitled

"An act to authorize the state conservation commission to acquire land and undertake an improvement program at certain state parks; to provide for financing through the issuance of revenue bonds; to provide the terms, conditions and limitations on such bonds; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state officers; to authorize the imposition of certain charges and fees for the payment and security of such bonds and for other purposes; to authorize the refunding of such bonds; and to prescribe penalties for violations of this act,"

as amended, being sections 318.301 to 318.316 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 1e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 149 of the Public Acts of 1960, as
2 amended, being sections 318.301 to 318.316 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1e to read as
4 follows:

1 SEC. 1E. THE DEPARTMENT MAY APPOINT PERSONS TO SERVE AS
2 VOLUNTEERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF FACILITATING THE RESPONSIBILITIES
3 OF THE DEPARTMENT AS PROVIDED IN THIS ACT. WHILE A VOLUNTEER IS
4 SERVING IN SUCH A CAPACITY, THE VOLUNTEER HAS THE SAME IMMUNITY
5 FROM CIVIL LIABILITY AS A DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEE AND SHALL BE
6 TREATED IN THE SAME MANNER AS AN EMPLOYEE UNDER SECTION 8 OF ACT
7 NO. 170 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1964, BEING SECTION 691.1408 OF THE
8 MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS. A VOLUNTEER SHALL NOT CARRY A FIREARM
9 WHILE FUNCTIONING AS A VOLUNTEER.
