

SENATE BILL No. 446

February 25, 1993, Introduced by Senators GEAKE, GAST and HOLMES and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of mental health and certain state purposes related to mental hygiene for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994; to provide for expenditure of the appropriations; and to provide for disposition of fees and other income received by the state agency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of mental health
