## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- 5 Sec 3 (1) "CHARITABLE PURPOSE" MEANS 1 OR MORE OF THE
- 6 FOLLOWING CAUSES, DEEDS, OR ACTIVITIES THAT IS BENEFICIAL TO THE
- 7 GENERAL PUBLIC
- 8 (A) RELIEF OF POVERTY

- 2 (C) ADVANCEMENT OF RELIGION
- 3 (D) PROTECTION OF HEALTH OR RELIEF FROM DISEASE, SUFFERING,

- 5 (E) ADVANCEMENT OF CIVIC, GOVERNMENTAL, OR MUNICIPAL
- 6 PURPOSES
- 7 (F) PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT AND CONSERVATION OF

- 12 within this state, not for pecuniary profit, whose primary pur-
- 13 pose is educational in nature and designed to develop the capa-
- 14 bilities of individuals by instruction in any public or private
- 15 elementary or secondary school -which- THAT complies with THE
- 16 SCHOOL CODE OF 1976 Act No 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
- 17 amended, being sections 380 1 to 380 1852 of the Michigan
- 18 Compiled Laws, or any private or public college or university,
- 19 not for pecuniary profit, and approved by the state board of
- 20 education
- 21 (3) -(2) "Fraternal organization" means an organization
- 22 within this state, except A college -fraternities- FRATERNITY OR
- 23 SORORITY, not for pecuniary profit, -which- THAT is a branch,
- 24 lodge, or chapter of a national or state organization and exists
- 25 for the common business, brotherhood, SISTERHOOD or other inter-
- 26 ests of its members

- 1 (4) -(3) "Licensee" means a PERSON OR qualified
- 2 organization licensed pursuant to this act
- 3 (5) -(4) "Member" means an individual who qualified for
- 4 membership in a qualified organization pursuant to its bylaws,
- 5 articles of incorporation, charter, rules, or other written
- 6 statement
- 7 (6) <del>(5)</del> "Person" means a natural person, firm, associa-
- 8 tion, corporation, or other legal entity
- 9 (7) -(6)— "Qualified organization" means a bona fide reli-
- 10 glous, educational, service, senior citizens, SOCIAL, fraternal,
- 11 or veterans' organization -which THAT operates without profit to
- 12 its members and -which- THAT either has been in existence contin-
- 13 uously as such an organization for a period of 5 years or is
- 14 exempt from taxation imposed by THE SINGLE BUSINESS TAX ACT, Act
- 15 No 228 of the Public Acts of 1975, as amended, being sections
- 16 208 1 to 208 145 of the Michigan Compiled Laws Qualified organ-
- 17 ization -shall- also -include- INCLUDES a candidate committee as
- 18 defined by, and which is organized pursuant to, THE MICHIGAN CAM-
- 19 PAIGN FINANCE ACT, Act No 388 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
- 20 amended, being sections 169 201 to 169 282 of the Michigan
- 21 Compiled Laws
- 22 (8) -(7)- "Religious organization" means an organization,
- 23 church, body of communicants, or group, not for pecuniary profit,
- 24 gathered in common membership for mutual support and edification
- 25 in piety, worship, and religious -obervances OBSERVANCES -or-
- 26 any society, not for pecuniary profit, of individuals united for

- 1 religious purposes at a definite place or a church related
- 2 private school, not for pecuniary profit
- 3 (9) -(8) "Senior citizens organization" means an organiza-
- 4 tion within this state, not for pecuniary profit, -which THAT
- 5 consists of at least 15 members who are 60 years of age or older
- 6 and exists for their mutual support and -advancing THE ADVANCE-
- 7 MENT OF the causes of elderly or retired persons
- 8 (10) <del>(9) "Service organization" means a branch, lodge, or</del>
- 9 chapter of a national or state organization, not for pecuniary
- 10 profit, -which- THAT is authorized by its written constitution,
- 11 charter, articles of incorporation, or bylaws to engage in a fra-
- 12 ternal, civic, or service purpose within the state and a local
- 13 civic organization, not for pecuniary profit and not affiliated
- 14 with a state or national organization, -which THAT is recognized
- 15 by resolution adopted by the -city LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL
- 16 SUBDIVISION in which the organization conducts its principal
- 17 activities, whose constitution, charter, articles of incorpora-
- 18 tion, or bylaws contain a provision for the perpetuation of the
- 19 organization as a nonprofit organization whose entire assets are
- 20 pledged to charitable purposes, and whose constitution, charter,
- 21 articles of incorporation, or bylaws contain a provision that all
- 22 assets, real property, and personal property shall revert to the
- 23 benefit of the -city government- GOVERNMENTAL SUBDIVISION THAT
- 24 GRANTED THE RESOLUTION upon dissolution of the organization
- 25 (11) "SOCIAL ORGANIZATION" MEANS AN ORGANIZATION WITHIN THIS
- 26 STATE, NOT FOR PECUNIARY PROFIT AND NOT A BRANCH, LODGE, OR
- 27 CHAPTER OF A NATIONAL OR STATE ORGANIZATION THAT EXISTS FOR THE

- 1 COMMON BUSINESS, BROTHERHOOD, SISTERHOOD, OR OTHER INTERESTS OF
- 2 ITS MEMBERS, AND, NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (7), HAS HAD AN
- 3 ACTIVE BANK ACCOUNT IN THE ORGANIZATION'S NAME FOR AT LEAST 5
- 4 CONTINUOUS YEARS HAS PROVISIONS IN ITS CONSTITUTION, CHARTER,
- 5 ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, OR BYLAWS FOR THE PERPETUATION OF THE
- 6 ORGANIZATION AS A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION AND THE REVERSION OF ALL
- 7 ASSETS, REAL PROPERTY, AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TO THE BENEFIT OF A
- 8 CHARITABLE PURPOSE UPON DISSOLUTION OF THE ORGANIZATION AND THAT
- 9 EXPENDS NOT LESS THAN 25% OF THE ANNUAL REVENUES RAISED BY CHARI-
- 10 TABLE GAMING FOR A CHARITABLE PURPOSE
- 11 (12) -(10) "Veterans' organization" means an organization
- 12 within this state, or a branch, -or lodge, or chapter within
- 13 this state of a state organization or of a national organization
- 14 chartered by the congress of the United States, not for pecuniary
- 15 profit, the membership of which consists of individuals who were
- 16 members of the armed services or forces of the United States
