A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4112 INTRODUCED 1-17-95

The bill would add a new section to the lobbying act (Public Act 472 of 1978) to prohibit lobbyists (or lobbyist agents) (1) from delivering (or causing to be delivered) PAC contributions (contributions from independent committees or political committees) to candidates (or to their staff or volunteers) and (2) from hand delivering campaign contributions to state legislators in the state Capitol building, a building housing legislative offices, or another building on a day in which a legislative committee had met in that building.
