## A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BLLL 4788 AS INTRODUCED 5-9-95

House Bill 4788 would repeal the act that provides for the use of certified mail wherever the statutes of this state use the terms "registered mail" or "registered mail, return receipt requested". The act currently allows for certified mailings to be used in place of registered mail where the law requires use of registered mail. The act treats a letter mailed through certfied mail with the same effect as if the mailing had been sent through registered mail.
