## HOUSE BILL No. 4138

January 17, 1995, Introduced by Rep. McBryde and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 21a of Act No. 319 of the Public

Acts of 1975, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the titling, licensure, and regulation of off-road recreation vehicles; to create certain funds; to create certain advisory bodies and to prescribe their powers and duties; to prescribe powers and duties of certain officers, agencies, and institutions; to provide certain tort immunity for certain governmental agencies under certain circumstances; to repeal certain parts of this act on a specific date; and to provide penalties and remedies,"

as amended by Act No. 241 of the Public Acts of 1989, being section 257.1621a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 21a of Act No. 319 of the Public Acts of 2 1975, as amended by Act No. 241 of the Public Acts of 1989, being 3 section 257.1621a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to 4 read as follows: Sec. 21a. If a peace officer has reasonable cause to believe that a person was —, at the time of an accident, the operator of an ORV involved in the accident and was operating the AN ORV while under the influence of an intoxicating liquor, a controlled substance as defined in section 7104 of the public health code, Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as amended, being section 333.7104 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, or a combination of intoxicating liquor and a controlled substance, or was operating the ORV while his or her ability to operate an ORV was impaired due to the consumption of intoxicating liquor, a controlled substance, the peace officer may arrest the alleged operator of the ORV without a warrant.
