

HOUSE BILL No. 4185

January 30, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Schroer and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 2 of chapter 83 of the Revised Statutes of 1846, entitled

"Of marriage and the solemnization thereof,"

being section 551.2 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 83 of the Revised Statutes
- 2 of 1846, being section 551.2 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 2. (1) Marriage, so far as its validity in law is con-
- 5 cerned, is a civil contract, to which the consent of parties
- 6 capable in law of contracting is essential. Consent alone
- 7 will not be enough IS NOT SUFFICIENT to effectuate a legal
- 8 marriage. from and after January 1, 1957. Consent must be
- 9 followed by the issuance of a license as provided for by IN

- 2 amended, being section 551.101 of the MICHIGAN Compiled Laws,
- 3 of 1948, or as provided for by IN section 1 of Act No. 180 of
- 4 the Public Acts of 1897, as amended, being section 551.201 of
- 5 the MICHIGAN Compiled Laws, -of 1948, and BY solemnization -,
- 6 as authorized by sections 7 to 18 , inclusive, of this act OF

- 8 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL HAS THE MENTAL CAPACITY TO CONSENT TO MAR-
- 9 RIAGE IF THE INDIVIDUAL UNDERSTANDS THE NATURE OF THE MARRIAGE
- 10 RELATIONSHIP AND THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THAT
- 11 RELATIONSHIP. AN INDIVIDUAL IS PRESUMED TO HAVE THE MENTAL
- 12 CAPACITY TO CONSENT TO MARRIAGE UNLESS THE INDIVIDUAL HAS A
- 13 GUARDIAN APPOINTED UNDER THE MENTAL HEALTH CODE, ACT NO. 258 OF
- 14 THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1974, BEING SECTIONS 330.1001 TO 330.2106 OF
- 15 THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, OR UNDER THE REVISED PROBATE CODE,
- 16 ACT NO. 642 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1978, BEING SECTIONS 700.1 TO
- 17 700.993 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, AND THERE IS A SPECIFIC
- 18 FINDING THAT THE INDIVIDUAL LACKS THE MENTAL CAPACITY TO CONSENT
- 19 TO MARRIAGE.
- 20 Section 2. Section 6 of chapter 83 of the Revised Statutes
- 21 of 1846, being section 551.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 22 repealed.
