

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4276**

February 1, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Nye and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend section 9 of Act No. 133 of the Public Acts of 1990, entitled

"Scrap tire regulatory act,"

being section 299.569 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 9 of Act No. 133 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1990, being section 299.569 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 9. (1) The scrap tire regulatory fund is created in
- 5 the state treasury. The fund shall receive money as provided by
- 6 law and any gifts or contributions to the fund. The state trea-
- 7 surer shall direct the investment of the fund. Interest and
- 8 earnings of the fund shall be credited to the fund. Money in the
- 9 fund at the close of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund and
- 10 shall not revert to the general fund.

- 1 (2) Money in the fund shall be used, upon appropriation, for 2 all of the following purposes:
- 3 (a) Not more than 50% of the money in the fund, annually,
- 4 for administrative costs of the department associated with this
- 5 act including the implementation and enforcement of this act, or
- 6 for the employment of not more than 13.5 full-time equated
- 7 positions.
- 8 (b) For the administrative costs of the secretary of state
- 9 associated with the collection of the tire disposal surcharge
- 10 pursuant to section 806 of the Michigan vehicle code, Act No. 300
- 11 of the Public Acts of 1949, being section 257.806 of the Michigan
- 12 Compiled Laws.
- (c) For the cleanup or collection of abandoned scrap tires.
- 14 on land owned by the state or a city, village, township, or
- 15 county.
- (3) The department shall annually report to the legislature
  17 on the utilization of revenues of the fund.
