Section 1. Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, as

SEC. 3406F. AN INSURER THAT DELIVERS, ISSUES FOR DELIVERY,
OR RENEWS IN THIS STATE ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1996 AN
EXPENSE-INCURRED HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL POLICY OR
CERTIFICATE SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE THAT AT A MINIMUM, AND WITH
ANNUAL OR LIFETIME BENEFITS EQUIVALENT TO THOSE FOR OTHER
