A bill to amend Act No. 2 of the Public Acts of 1921, enti-

tled

"An act to promote the efficiency of the government of the state, to create a state administrative board, to define the powers and duties thereof, to provide for the transfer to said board of powers and duties now vested by law in other boards, commissions, departments and officers of the state, and for the abolishing of certain of the boards, commissions, departments and offices, whose powers and duties are hereby transferred,"

being sections 17.1 to 17.3 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 2a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Act No. 2 of the Public Acts of 1921, being sec tions 17.1 to 17.3 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by
 adding section 2a to read as follows:

SEC. 2A. THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD SHALL HAVE THE
POWERS GRANTED AND PERFORM THE DUTIES IMPOSED UNDER THE MICHIGAN
RENAISSANCE ZONE ACT.
