

HOUSE BILL No. 5293

October 25, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Hill and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 215 of the Public Acts of 1895, entitled as amended
"The fourth class city act,"
as amended by Act No. 19 of the Public Acts of 1994, being section 89.2 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 215 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1895, as amended by Act No. 19 of the Public Acts of 1994, being
- 3 section 89.2 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) The council of a city may prescribe a sanction
- 6 for the violation of an ordinance.
- 7 (2) Consistent with any of the following statutes, the
- 8 council may adopt an ordinance that designates a violation of the

- 2 that violation:
- 3 (a) The Michigan vehicle code, Act No. 300 of the Public
- 4 Acts of 1949, being sections 257.1 to 257.923 of the Michigan
- 5 Compiled Laws.
- 6 (b) Act No. 235 of the Public Acts of 1969, being
- 7 sections 257.941 to 257.943 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 8 (c) Act No. 62 of the Public Acts of 1956, being
- 9 sections 257.951 to 257.954 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 10 (3) Consistent with the marine safety act, Act No. 303 of
- 11 the Public Acts of 1967, being sections 281,1001 to 281,1199 of
- 12 the Michigan Compiled Laws, the council may adopt an ordinance
- 13 that designates a violation of the ordinance as a marine law
- 14 civil infraction and provides a civil fine for that violation.
- 15 This subsection does not apply unless House Bill No. 4639 of the
- 16 87th Legislature is enacted into law.
- 17 (3) -(4) The council may adopt an ordinance that designates
- 18 a violation of the ordinance as a municipal civil infraction and
- 19 provides a civil fine for that violation. An ordinance may not
- 20 designate a violation as a municipal civil infraction if that
- 21 violation may be designated as a civil infraction under
- 22 subsection (2). or as a marine law civil infraction under
- 23 subsection (3). A statute may provide that a violation of a spe-
- 24 cific type of ordinance is a municipal civil infraction whether
- 25 or not the ordinance designates the violation as a municipal
- 26 civil infraction.

- (4) (5) An ordinance shall not make an act or omission a municipal civil infraction if that act or omission constitutes a crime under any of the following:

- (c) The Michigan vehicle code, Act No. 300 of the Public 11 Acts of 1949, being sections 257.1 to 257.923 of the Michigan 12 Compiled Laws.
- (d) The Michigan liquor control act, Act No. 8 of the Public 14 Acts of the Extra Session of 1933, being sections 436.1 to 436.58 15 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- (e) The marine safety act, Act No. 303 of the Public Acts
 17 of 1967, being sections 281.1001 to 281.1199 PART 801 (MARINE
 18 SAFETY) OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
 19 ACT, ACT NO. 451 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1994, BEING SECTIONS

- 9 (j) Any law of this state under which the act or omission is 10 punishable by imprisonment for more than 90 days.
- (5) + For the violation of an ordinance other than an
- 12 ordinance described in subsection (2) $\overline{}$ OR (3), $\overline{}$ or (4), the
- 13 council may prescribe a fine or forfeiture not exceeding \$500.00,
- 14 unless a greater fine or forfeiture is authorized in this act, or
- 15 imprisonment not exceeding 180 days, or both, in the discretion
- 16 of the court, together with the costs of prosecution for each
- 17 violation of the ordinance; may provide that the offender, on
- 18 failing to pay a fine or forfeiture, or the costs of prosecution,
- 19 may be imprisoned for a term not exceeding 180 days unless pay-
- 20 ment is made before the expiration of the term; and may direct
- 21 the imprisonment to be in the county jail of the county within
- 22 which the city is located or in a prison or other place of con-
- 23 finement in the state as provided by law.
- 24 (6) -(7) A sanction for the violation of an ordinance shall
- 25 be prescribed in the ordinance.
