

HOUSE BILL No. 5321

October 25, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Freeman and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend section 14f of Act No. 154 of the Public Acts of 1974, entitled as amended "Michigan occupational safety and health act," as added by Act No. 80 of the Public Acts of 1986, being section 408.1014f of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 14f of Act No. 154 of the Public Acts of

- 4 read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 14f. (1) An employer engaged in agricultural opera-
- 6 tions is not required to comply with the standard incorporated by
- 7 reference in section 14a or sections 14b to 14l for a hazardous
- 8 chemical that is regulated under the FEDERAL insecticide,
- 9 fungicide, and rodenticide act, -7 U.S.C. 136 to 136y, or the

- I pesticide control act, Act No. 171 of the Public Acts of 1976,
- 2 being sections 286.55+ to 286.58+ CHAPTER 125, 86 STAT. 973, 7
- 3 U.S.C. 136 TO 1361 AND 1361 TO 1364, OR PART 83 (PESTICIDE
- 4 CONTROL) OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
- 5 ACT, ACT NO. 451 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1994, BEING SECTIONS
- 6 324.8301 TO 324.8336 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, and any rules
- 7 or regulations promulgated under those acts.
- 8 (2) The director of the department of agriculture at least
- 9 annually shall certify to the department of public health a list
- 10 of chemicals regulated by the acts described in subsection (1).
