 Laws, is amended by adding section 10b to read as follows:

4 SEC. 10B. AN ASSESSOR OR HIS OR HER AGENT SHALL NOT ENTER A
5 PERSON'S HOMESTEAD FOR PURPOSES OF ASSESSMENT WITHOUT THAT
6 PERSON'S CONSENT. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "HOMESTEAD" MEANS
7 THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 7DD.
