

HOUSE BILL No. 5549

January 31, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Fitzgerald, Cropsey, Dalman, Ryan, Lowe, Bush and Jersevic and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 82118 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, entitled

"The natural resources and environmental protection act," as added by Act No. 58 of the Public Acts of 1995, being section 324.82118 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 82118 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts
 of 1994, as added by Act No. 58 of the Public Acts of 1995, being
 section 324.82118 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to
 read as follows:

Sec. 82118. (1) In addition to registration of a snowmobile
pursuant to section 82105 or registration in another state or
province, beginning October 1, 1994, a person who desires to
operate a snowmobile in this state shall purchase a Michigan
snowmobile trail permit sticker. The Michigan snowmobile trail

1 permit issued under this section shall be valid for a period of 2 1 year which begins on October 1 and ends on the following 3 September 30. The fee for the permit is \$10.00. Fifty cents of 4 the fee shall be retained by the department for administrative 5 costs. Fifty cents of the fee shall be retained by the agent 6 selling the permit. Nine dollars of the fee shall be credited to 7 the recreational snowmobile trail improvement fund created in 8 section 82110.

9 (2) The trail permit sticker shall be permanently affixed to10 the forward half of the snowmobile.

11 (3) The department may contract with a person to act as an 12 agent of the department of state for the purpose of issuing 13 Michigan snowmobile trail permits. The department of state shall 14 sell the permits to agents in bulk. Agents may obtain a refund 15 from the department for any permits that are not sold.

16 (4) An agent who uses or allows the use of a permit by 17 anyone except the snowmobile user to whom the permit is sold is 18 guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of \$50.00 for each 19 instance of such use or allowed use.

(5) The department of state may suspend a certificate of
registration when the department of state determines that the
required fee has not been paid and remains unpaid after reasonable notice or demand. In addition to the required fee, a \$10.00
penalty shall be assessed and collected against any person who
tenders an insufficient check or draft in payment of the fee.
(6) A person who fails to secure a permit under this section
is responsible for a civil infraction and -subject MAY BE
