

HOUSE BILL No. 5892

May 21, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Harder, Curtis, Baade and Pitoniak and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended

"Michigan vehicle code,"

as amended, being sections 257.1 to 257.923 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 601b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, as
 amended, being sections 257.1 to 257.923 of the Michigan Compiled
 Laws, is amended by adding section 601b to read as follows:
 SEC. 601B. (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS
 ACT, A PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR A MOVING VIOLATION AT AN EMERGENCY
 SCENE IS SUBJECT TO A FINE THAT IS DOUBLE THE FINE OTHERWISE PRE 7 SCRIBED FOR THAT MOVING VIOLATION.

1 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

2 (A) "EMERGENCY SCENE" MEANS A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT, A SERIOUS
3 INCIDENT CAUSED BY WEATHER CONDITIONS, OR ANOTHER OCCURRENCE
4 ALONG A HIGHWAY OR STREET FOR WHICH A POLICE OFFICER, FIRE FIGHT5 ER, OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL PERSONNEL ARE SUMMONED TO AID AN INJURED
6 VICTIM.

7 (B) "MOVING VIOLATION" MEANS AN ACT OR OMISSION PROHIBITED 8 UNDER THIS ACT OR A LOCAL ORDINANCE SUBSTANTIALLY CORRESPONDING 9 TO THIS ACT THAT OCCURS WHILE A PERSON IS OPERATING A MOTOR VEHI-10 CLE, AND FOR WHICH THE PERSON IS SUBJECT TO A FINE.
