A bill to amend section 8707 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," being section 324.8707 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 8707 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts
 of 1994, being section 324.8707 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 8707. (1) The director, in conjunction with the 5 Michigan state university cooperative extension service and the 6 agricultural experiment station in cooperation with the United 7 State department of agriculture soil and conservation service and 8 the agricultural stabilization and conservation service, the 9 department of <u>natural resources</u> ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY, and 10 other professional and industry organizations, shall develop

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1 groundwater stewardship practices for approval by the

2 -commissioner COMMISSION of agriculture and upon approval shall
3 promote their implementation.

4 (2) The director, in conjunction with Michigan state univer5 sity, the department of <u>natural resources</u> ENVIRONMENTAL
6 QUALITY, and other persons the director considers appropriate,
7 shall develop a voluntary on-site evaluation system for pesticide
8 or nitrogen fertilizer use. The on-site evaluation system shall
9 be designed to do all of the following:

(a) Provide persons with the ability to voluntarily deter11 mine the relative groundwater impact potential posed by their use
12 of pesticides and nitrogen fertilizers.

(b) Provide persons with the ability to determine the degree
14 to which operations are in accord with groundwater stewardship
15 practices and applicable groundwater protection rules.

(c) Prioritize operational changes at the site level17 intended to protect groundwater.

(d) Guide persons to appropriate technical and educationalmaterials.

20 (3) INFORMATION OBTAINED PURSUANT TO A VOLUNTARY ON-SITE
21 EVALUATION DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) IS NOT SUBJECT TO DIS22 CLOSURE UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT, ACT NO. 442 OF THE
23 PUBLIC ACTS OF 1976, BEING SECTIONS 15.231 TO 15.246 OF THE
24 MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.

(4) -(3) The director, in conjunction with the groundwater
advisory council, shall review and evaluate the effectiveness of
groundwater stewardship practices adopted under subsection (1).

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
