

HOUSE BILL No. 6122

September 25, 1996, Introduced by Rep. Law and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend section 3109a of Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, entitled as amended
"The insurance code of 1956,"
being section 500.3109a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3109a of Act No. 218 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1956, being section 500.3109a of the Michigan Compiled Laws,
- 3 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 3109a. An insurer providing personal protection insur-
- 5 ance benefits shall offer, at appropriately reduced premium
- 6 rates, deductibles and exclusions reasonably related to other
- 7 health and accident coverage on the insured. The deductibles and
- 8 exclusions required to be offered by this section shall be
- 9 subject to prior approval by the commissioner and shall apply
- 10 -only- to benefits payable to -the- ANY person -named in-

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- 1 ENTITLED TO BENEFITS UNDER the policy, the spouse of the insured
- 2 and any relative of either domiciled in the same household
- 3 INCLUDING BENEFITS PAYABLE TO A PERSON PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 3111,
- 4 3114, AND 3115.
