

## **SENATE BILL No. 160**

January 31, 1995, Introduced by Senator SHUGARS and referred to the Committee on Human Resources, Labor and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend Act No. 453 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended

Elliott-Larsen civil rights act,"

as amended, being sections 37.2101 to 37.2804 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 602b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 453 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
- 2 amended, being sections 37.2101 to 37.2804 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 602b to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 SEC. 602B. (1) IF THE DEPARTMENT FINDS A PERSON'S EQUAL
- 6 EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY PRACTICES IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE COVENANT
- 7 REQUIRED BY SECTION 209, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE THE PERSON A
- 8 CERTIFICATE OF AWARDABILITY.

- 1 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE OR DENY THE CERTIFICATE OF
- 2 AWARDABILITY WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE THE DEPARTMENT
- 3 RECEIVES THE REQUEST FOR REVIEW UNDER SECTION 602A.
- 4 (3) IF THE DEPARTMENT DENIES A CERTIFICATE OF AWARDABILITY,
- 5 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL STATE IN ITS FINDINGS THE SPECIFIC REASONS
- 6 FOR DENIAL.
- 7 (4) UNLESS THE DEPARTMENT HAS REVOKED A CERTIFICATE OF AWAR-
- 8 DABILITY BECAUSE THE PERSON IS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE COVE-
- 9 NANT REQUIRED BY SECTION 209, THE CERTIFICATE REMAINS IN EFFECT
- 10 FOR 2 YEARS AFTER THE DATE THE CERTIFICATE WAS ISSUED.
