

SENATE BILL No. 188

February 1, 1995, Introduced by Senator BOUCHARD and referred to the Committee on Financial Services.

A bill to allow the secretary of state to accept credit card payments in certain financial transactions.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) The secretary of state may accept a credit
- 2 card, in lieu of cash, check, or money order, as payment of a
- 3 tax, fee, price, or charge required under any act or rule promul-
- 4 gated under the authority of an act administered by the secretary
- 5 of state or under which the secretary of state is responsible for
- 6 collecting a tax, fee, price, or charge. The secretary of state
- 7 shall determine which major credit cards may be accepted for pay-
- 8 ment under those acts.
- 9 (2) The secretary of state may accept by telephone the
- 10 number of a credit card described in subsection (1) as payment of
- 11 a tax, fee, price, or charge described in subsection (1).
