

SENATE BILL No. 205

February 1, 1995, Introduced by Senators MC MANUS and NORTH and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Tourism.

A bill to amend section 5 of Act No. 221 of the Public Acts of 1987, entitled

"Recreation improvement fund act,"

being section 318.535 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 5 of Act No. 221 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1987, being section 318.535 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 5. (1) The purchaser of qasoline for the operation of
- 5 vessels excepted from this act by section 1 shall be 2 IS enti-
- 6 tled to a refund of tax paid on that gasoline, upon filing a
- 7 sworn claim with the department of treasury, upon forms pre-
- 8 scribed and furnished by it, within 6 months from the date of
- 9 purchase, as shown by the invoice. The retail distributor shall
- 10 furnish a purchaser with an invoice showing the amount of

- 1 gasoline purchased, the date of the purchase, and the total
- 2 amount of tax paid on the purchase. Each dealer or distributor
- 3 shall keep a copy of the invoices issued for a period of 2 years
- 4 subject to examination by the department of treasury. Each claim
- 5 for refund shall have attached to the claim the original invoice
- 6 received by the purchaser, and when approved by the department of
- 7 treasury, the claims shall be paid out of the state waterways
- 8 fund upon warrant of the department of treasury.
- 9 (2) A person who makes a false statement in a claim or
- 10 invoice presented to the department of treasury, -or who
- 11 presents to the department of treasury a claim or invoice con-
- 12 taining a false statement, or who collects or causes to be paid
- 13 to the person or any other person a refund without being entitled
- 14 to the refund, shall forfeit the full amount of the claim and is
- 15 guilty of a misdemeanor.
