



# SENATE BILL No. 327

February 23, 1995, Introduced by Senator GAST and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of agriculture for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by various agencies.

1       Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of agriculture

3 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from
