

SENATE BILL No. 334

February 23, 1995, Introduced by Senator GAST and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of social services and certain state purposes related to public welfare services for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the state agency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of social services and certain state purposes related to public welfare as set forth in this act for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, from the following funds: General fund......\$ Federal funds......\$

In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of arti-6 cle IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state 7 resources in this appropriations act for the fiscal year ending 8 September 30, 1996 is \$______ and state appropriations paid to 9 units of local government are 0.

The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under 11 this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices, and programs 12 for which appropriations are made under this act are subject to Act 13 No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of 14 the Michigan Compiled Laws.
