

SENATE BILL No. 360

March 1, 1995, Introduced by Senator GEAKE and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 7 of the Public Acts of 1981, entitled

"An act to prohibit without authorization the bringing into jails and other specified areas any alcoholic liquor, controlled substances, weapons, and certain other items; the selling or furnishing to prisoners, and the improper disposal of any alcoholic liquor, controlled substances, weapons, and certain other items; the possession or control by prisoners of any alcoholic liquor, controlled substances, weapons, and certain other items; to prescribe a penalty; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

as amended by Act No. 46 of the Public Acts of 1985, being section 801.261 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Alcoholic liquor" means any spiritous SPIRITUOUS,
- 3 vinous, malt, or fermented liquor, liquid, or compound whether or
- 4 not medicated, containing 1/2 of 1% or more of alcohol by volume,
- 5 and which is or readily can be made suitable as a beverage.
- 6 (b) "Controlled substance" means a drug, substance, or imme-
- 7 diate precursor in schedules 1 to 5 of part 72 of THE PUBLIC
- 8 HEALTH CODE, Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as
- 9 amended, being sections 333.7201 to 333.7231 of the Michigan
- 10 Compiled Laws.
- 11 (c) "Jail" means a municipal or county jail, work-camp,
- 12 lockup, holding center, half-way house, community corrections
- 13 center, house of correction, or any other facility maintained by
- 14 a municipality or county, -which- OR MAINTAINED BY A PRIVATE
- 15 ENTITY UNDER CONTRACT WITH A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY PURSUANT TO
- 16 THE ALTERNATIVE JAILS ACT, THAT houses prisoners.
- 17 (d) "Prisoner" means a person incarcerated in a jail or a
- 18 person committed to a jail for incarceration who is a participant
- 19 in a work release or vocational or educational study release
- 20 program.
- 21 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
